Now that we've gone through one weekend digitally, you might be wondering, what about **next** weekend?

As you may have seen, Wisconsin's governor has mandated the statewide closure of all K-12 schools and the president, in cooperation with the CDC, has issued new mandates urging people to avoid gathering in groups of 10 or more.

Given these new mandates and because we're still leading with the question what's the wise thing to do?, The Ridge's physical campuses will not hold in-person services and will continue to go digital until Sunday, April 5 in order to protect the health and safety of our community. We will reevaluate this date as we continue to learn more.
