



PRAYING INTO EASTER

April 5

Focus for Today:

Today we will expand our view of where worship should occur. Many believe that worship is isolated to a particular place or location, though God is not concerned with location or place as much as we may be. If your worship of God has been isolated to a place or location(s) today we encourage you to challenge this view. Reflect on the many locations and places you can worship God.

Daily Scripture:

John 4:19-23: Oh, so you're a prophet! Well, tell me this: Our ancestors worshiped God at this mountain, but you Jews insist that Jerusalem is the only place for worship, right?" Believe me, woman, the time is coming when you Samaritans will worship the Father neither here at this mountain nor there in Jerusalem. You worship guessing in the dark; we Jews worship in the clear light of day. God's way of salvation is made available through the Jews. But the time is coming—it has, in fact, come—when what you're called will not matter and where you go to worship will not matter.

Prayer Example:

Father, expand my view of what worshipping You truly means! Help me to worship You everywhere I go and to not limit my worship of You to a particular place or location. As I go throughout the day today, help me to worship You wherever I am.
